Meeting was opened at 7:03

**Minutes:** Minutes from last meeting approved as presented? Accepted by the 4 members above, excluding Beverly.

Correspondence: Meeting ground letter seeking donation. 1)Will give \$100. (see attached). 2)Audit report was good. 3) Diocese of Easton: a) Thank you for Nets for Life Donation. 4) Proposed Canon of Indebtedness letter- Matt reviewed and will explain to Beverly at Finance Committee meeting. 5) Diocesan Pledge request was reviewed. This to be deferred until next calendar year (2011). 6) Clergy compensation Guide was reviewed, so members would be aware of this when Trinity needs to hire a new priest.

#### Ministry Areas – Team Reports as Available/Necessary:

- **A. Finance/Stewardship (David, Mary Helen)** Finance- Members discussed looking into alternate companies for electric rates. Mary Helen to give Matt electric bill so he can research lower rates. Budget- Pledges are up. Over budget in some areas. Some of this is due to timing of retirement approval from Dioceses. Mary Helen & Matt will figure out where overages and shortages are. September's Treasurer's Report- not accepted due to lack of quorum.
- **B.** Leadership /Pastoral Care/Warden Report (Beverly, Charlie) —Bishop is coming Wednesday evening. He will speak with parishioners regarding recent changes.
- **C. Building/Grounds (Allen)** Allen absent: will revisit roof repair and next door parking New microphone. Parish Hall- air conditioning is needed. It was uncomfortable for coffee hours which affected retention of newcomers. Thanks to the boy Scouts removing stumps.
- **D.** Worship/Music/Adult Ed. & Spiritual Life (Beverly/Judy/Margaret)- Attendance on 10/10 was @ 60 people (both services).

What is it, what does it do, and who does it serve? These may be a few questions you have about the appeal we are making this month. At one time there actually was a children's home, but in the 1950's it was sold and women from the Diocese began a foundation with the proceeds. The original mission was to aid deserving and needy children, and for over 50 years we have continued to do the same through scholarships and camperships. The specific mission of the Children's Home Foundation is to raise and distribute money that will allow students from the Diocese to attend career and technology training (usually two or three year training) that will equip them to enter the world of work. We are looking for the student who would not otherwise be able to handle the financial burden of continuing education. We have sent students to a variety of schools: welding, nursing, auto mechanics, early childhood education, culinary, cosmetology and others. Our candidates need not be Episcopalian...just needy, deserving to succeed.

The board has also chosen to dedicate some of the foundation funds to sending youngsters to summer camps. Again, these are children who would not be able to afford the camp experience without scholarship support.

So, you will hear more from me this month and hope you will consider making a "Thanksgiving" contribution to this cause. Checks are to made to The Children's Home Foundation. Your donation is tax deductible.




