

# **Urban Immersion DC Mission Trip**

June 19 - June 23 for 6th - 12th Graders

\*The church will be decorated in red plants and flowers

OVERVIEW The group departs in vans from Christ Church, Easton at 4:00 pm on Sunday and heads to St. Alban's in Washngton, D.C. We stay in the old rectory building next to the church, located on the grounds of the National Cathedral. Students sleep on the floor so mats or air mattresses are recommended. Boys and Girls sleep in separate areas with separate bathrooms. We eat breakfasts & dinners in the rectory and pack a bagged lunch to go each day. Thursday is our "free day" when we head to Harpers Ferry for a day of fun on the Shenandoah and Potomac. Here we experience tubing or white water rapids. We arrive back at Christ Church at 8:00 pm on Thursday night.

WHAT WE DO Each day we rotate through various ministry sites that could include Martha's Table, Charlie's Place, Capital Area Food Bank, Children of Mine School, or Food & Friends. We may prepare & distribute food to the homeless, pack boxes of school supplies, tutor & play with lowincome children, etc! One night we share dinner in an area ethnic restaurant as part of our discussion on diversity and culture. Each night ends with a "debriefing" of the day's events at a local monument or hotspot. The debrief includes biblical discussion, reflections, and lots of prayer. We finish our week with a day trip to Harper's Ferry, WV where we will enjoy a ride on the river with River Riders & visit historic locations.

COST & PREPARATION The cost per student of the trip is \$200 all inclusive. This covers transportation, housing, food, & programs. Scholarships of up to \$100 are available upon written request (these requests are kept confidential). Students can raise additional funds by assisting in local fundraisers with their church.
