Joy L. McDonald Coltvet wrote in Currents in Theology and Mission (Dec.9, 2007) "So who is coming this Advent? Which Jesus? Is it Jesus the shoot from the stump, signal of hope and transformation into peace, or is it Jesus the one bearing the axe, the winnowing fork, the bringer of fire? The answer is Yes-both. At the same time, the answer is Neither. Jesus surprises people by what he does not do. Jesus does not conquer the earth with military force, become king, bring absolute order. Jesus also surprises people by what he does do- Jesus does bring diverse people together into one community, lead by going to the cross to suffer and die, send people out to transform the world."
