Parish House Repairs

The Vestry has approved the Church and Parish House repairs to be done by Leelands Slate Roof Company for \$15,158.38 that will be done this Fall. The following repairs are: Parish House: Ridge Cap painting, Gutter replacement, Parish House right side, and Gutter repair .Parish House left side Church: Ridge Cap painting, Wooden Cross repairs, Bell Tower Roof Top metal painting, and Bell Tower flashing replacement. The above plus earlier Church slate roof repair and Parish House roof replacement will fix the most critical Church exterior repair needs and restore appearance.


Treasurers Report: Balance \$4,315.37
