### Re-Dedication of the Rev Duke Log House, Friday, May 5th

All are welcome to join the celebration on re opening from 5 to 8 PM. 135 East Main St. Elkton. Parking can be found behind the courthouse building across the street. The log cabin life on Bow Street in Elkton began around 1800 and has served multiple purposes: a residence, a barber shop, a store, etc. The cabin is historically significant for it was once the home of The Rev. William Duke, who took the title of the cabin and land in 1820. It was use for his residence and his own school. Rev. Duke was an Episcopal Priest and a school master.


